RE-OPENING INFORMATION

We're very excited to start ministering to our Next Generation in person again!!

Our goal has always been to provide a safe, loving, fun environment where children can learn about and grow in their walk with Jesus! We have been prayerfully planning how to best minister to the children and families God has placed under our care and we feel that whatever decision each family makes, it will be the right choice for them.

With that said, we want you to know that we value and support the "PARENT'S CHOICE"! Therefore in addition to in person ministry, we will continue offering all of our online ministry videos & activities indefinitely on our website at www.goodlettsville.church

If you choose to bring your child into our ministry areas, there are some important things you need to know along with some very different guidelines that we will be following. Please read all the information carefully before making your decision and be sure to talk to your child about the new procedures and expectations.

All Next Gen Ministry rooms & activities have been adjusted to attempt to meet social distancing guidelines and try to keep everyone and leaders safe & healthy. While we know there is no way to prevent the possibility of exposure to illnesses, however we hope by adding some additional precautions to what we were already doing may help lessen the risks.

- All Next Gen Ministry areas will be sanitized and wiped down before and after each Sunday morning session.
- All staff and volunteers will wear either face shields or masks and will undergo the wellness check procedures prior to serving
- Promiseland Children in 1st grade and up will be required to wear masks.
- Check in will be done by a staff or volunteer along with our new Wellness Check-in procedures. Those procedures include parent/guardian sign off on wellness checklist and temp checks.
- Only one parent/guardian that has met the check in procedures may walk their child to the classroom area for drop off and the same parent/guardian may pick them up once it is over (watch for new traffic patterns to help alleviate congested areas)
- Preschool (potty trained 3 year olds thru Kindergarten) & Elementary age (1st-5th grade) rooms will have markers on the floor to designate 6 feet apart during check-in & ministry times
- Due to limited volunteers and lack of sink/changing stations in rooms, only children that are fully potty trained will be able to attend in our preschool and elementary classrooms.
- Our toddler & nursery rooms are fully equipped for diaper changing and are set up to accommodate ages birth to 3 years old. We will provide each child a basket for the parent to place diapers, 1 change of clothes in a ziploc & a bottle (if needed). We will not be taking diaper bags into the rooms in order to help alleviate cross contamination.
- No snacks will be served and no food will be permitted in any of the classrooms. (Parents may still send bottles with infants and young toddlers for the staff/volunteers to administer - no sippy cups or anything the child would use on his or her own.)
- Hand sanitizer is required to be used by all preschool and elementary age children, staff & volunteers prior to entering classrooms. It will be available at check in, in every classroom and throughout the church.
- Some toys will be available in certain rooms and will be sanitized before and after each use. No outside toys or items will be allowed to be brought in.

While present in the facility your child will be in contact with children and adults who are also at risk of community exposure to a variety of illnesses. By entering our church & leaving your child in our care, you understand that while we have policies and procedures to sanitize and attempt to lessen exposure, nothing will remove 100% of the risk of exposure to COVID-19 as well as other illnesses.
